- Greece ratified the Macolin Convention in 2020
- Presidency of the Follow Up Committee 2021-25
- Relevant laws
 - Law 4639/2019 Ratification of Macolin Convention
 - Law 4809/2021 Exchange of information
 - Sport Law 2725/1999 Article 132 (criminal offense)
 - Law 4726/2020 Establishment of National Platform (EPATHLA)
 - Article 13 of Macolin Convention

- EPATHLA functions
 - National coordination of the stakeholders
 - Monitoring and Collection of information

 - International cooperation

- Budget ~200 k€








Flowchart










Safety, Security and Services

Greece and the Saint Denis Convention

- Greece ratified the Saint denis Convention in 2022
 - Position of Vice chairman in the Follow Up Committee 2025-2027
- Relevant laws
 - Sport law 2725/1999 Articles 41A-41K (about 35 pages)
 - Law 4901/2022 Ratification of the Saint Denis Convention
 - Law 5085/2024 Creation of the National Coordination Committee
- Ministerial decisions:
 - licensing of sport facilities (2024)
 - Safety regulation for sport events (update in 2025)





Main interventions after 2022

- Law 5085/2024 significantly amended Law 2725/1999
 - High definition cameras
 - Strong identification of those entering tha stadia (via mobile phone)
 - Standing Committee for Sport Violence
 - administrative sanctions to club and physical persons
- National coordination committee
 - Four working groups on:
 - Update of safety regulation, national strategy, implementation of banning orders, steward training
- Police: Intense training, networking, exercises
- August 2025:Action plan based on 2024 recommendations





Good governance

Some basic good governance provisions

 Term limit for the board members of the sport federations

 Gender balance: at least 1/3 of one gender in sport federation boards

- Publish seven mandatory regulations
 - Competitions, national teams, transactions, disciplinary, ethics, antidoping, refereeing
- Funding of sport federations based on evaluation



Sport federation evaluation: CHILON

• Based on 4 criteria: Size, Performance, Activity, Governance



Digital transformation

- Registry of sport clubs
 - Information source for the sport club funding criteria
- e-kouros platform
 - Amateur sport
 - Sport for all
 - Sport facilities
- A very useful database
 - Geographical and sectoral data
 - Tool for decision making







Safeguarding

Safeguarding – the Greek experience

- Various incidents (basketball, gymnastics, rowing...)
- In 2021 the "me too" movement in Greece started from sport
 - "start to talk" event, confession of a sailing Olympic winner
- Sport Law 2725/1999 articles 23A and 23B
 - as amended by law 5176/2025
 - Standing Committee for Safeguarding in GSS
 - Safeguarding Officer obligatory in all federations
 - Specific qualifications and training



Standing Committee of Safeguarding

- 13 Members: 3 GSS, 4 other Ministries, 1 HOC, 5 scientists
- a) the protection of the physical and psychological integrity of athletes,
- b) the prevention of sexual harassment and abuse in sports,
- c) the planning of actions to deal with abusive behaviour in sport,
- d) the submission of relevant recommendations to the Sport Minister,
- e) the production of training material,
- f) the conduct of training seminars and the issuance of relevant certificates of attendance,
- g) cooperation with other competent bodies.




Parallel actions

- National Action Plan for the Protection of Children from Sexual Abuse and Exploitation
- Start to talk Toolkit in Greek
- Memoranda of Understanding (Universities, institutes, NGO)
- Incident Reporting Platform
 - Already in place CAN-MDS for children
- Coach Training



Safeguarding – education of coaches

- Exploit and adjust existent material
- CICEE-T An Erasmus program for Culturally Informed Safe Sport Coach Education e-toolbox
 - Mediterranean countries, available in Greek
 - Mandatory in the coach schools of GSS



Concluding remarks

Greece and Sport Integrity

- Why is sport integrity a key priority?
 - It has to do with values
 - Educational role
 - At the core of sport
- Greece has an additional reason to promote sport integrity, as the motherland of values-based sport
- Modern Challenge:
 - Tackling threats to sport integrity, a task that requires a synergetic, cooperative, holistic approach
